

All Delawareans ages 16+ are now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine

DE encourages residents to take first vaccination opportunity available to them; only the Pfizer vaccine is FDA-authorized for ages 16-17

Delawareans 16+ may obtain vaccination through the following channels



Pharmacies

- View list of pharmacies at de.gov/pharmacies
- Pharmacies have their own waitlist and scheduling systems



State of DE vaccination events

- Sign up for the state waitlist at vaccinerequest.delaware.gov or by calling 1-833-643-1715 (press option 2)
- Appointment invites are based on age and health risk factors
- Invites may be for drive-thru events or indoor events



Medical providers

Includes primary care & specialty providers, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and hospital systems

- Call your provider for an appointment; if they are not vaccinating patients, they will provide your info to a health care system which will contact you to schedule an appointment
- Providers are asked to use their clinical judgment to continue to prioritize persons with [high-risk medical conditions, including disabilities](#)



Community-based events

- Sign-ups for these local events are coordinated by community organizations

Additional opportunities for key groups

Frontline and other essential workers

- Some employers may organize vaccination opportunities
- Employers can reach out to VaccinePlanning@delaware.gov if interested in identifying a vaccinating partner for employees

Long-term care residents and staff

- Residents and staff can be vaccinated by LTC staff if the LTCF is an enrolled provider
- Staff may also make an appointment with [Walgreens](#)
