Domestic Travel

	Not Vaccinated	Fully Vaccinated
Before travel: get tested 3-5 days prior to departure	X	
After travel: get tested 3-5 days after return	X	
Self-quarantine after travel for 7 days if test is negative or for 10 days if not tested	X	
Self-monitor for symptoms	X	X
Wear a mask and take precautions during travel	X	X
Avoid being around people who are at increased risk for severe illness for 14 days, whether you get tested or not.*	X

International Travel

	Not Vaccinated	Fully Vaccinated
Before travel: get tested 3-5 days prior to departure from the U.S.	X	
Prior to return to the U.S.: mandatory test 3 days prior to return	X	X
After travel: get tested 3-5 days after return to the U.S.	X	X
Self-quarantine after travel for 7 days if test is negative or for 10 days if not tested	X	
Self-monitor for symptoms	X	X
Wear a mask and take precautions during travel	X	X
Avoid being around people who are at increased risk for severe illness for 14 days, whether you get tested or not.*	X
