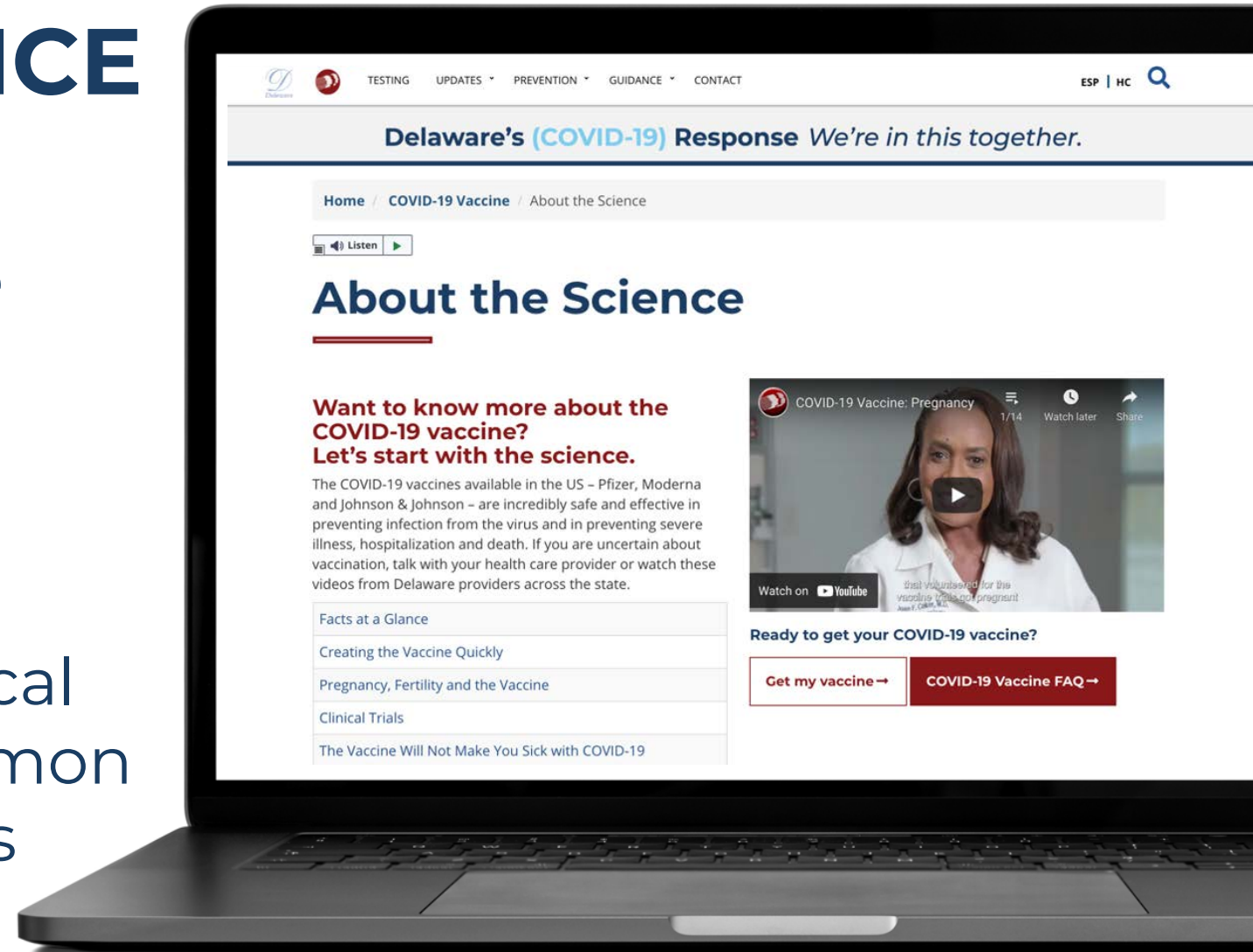

CDC ISSUED UPDATED GUIDANCE FOR K-12 SCHOOLS

- **Should promote vaccination for eligible individuals**
- **Masks should be worn indoors by all individuals (age 2 and older) who are not fully vaccinated**
- **Should maintain at least 3 feet of physical distance between students within classrooms when possible, combined with mask wearing for unvaccinated persons**
- **Importance of layered prevention strategies** (e.g., physical distancing, mask use, screening, testing, cleaning and disinfecting)
