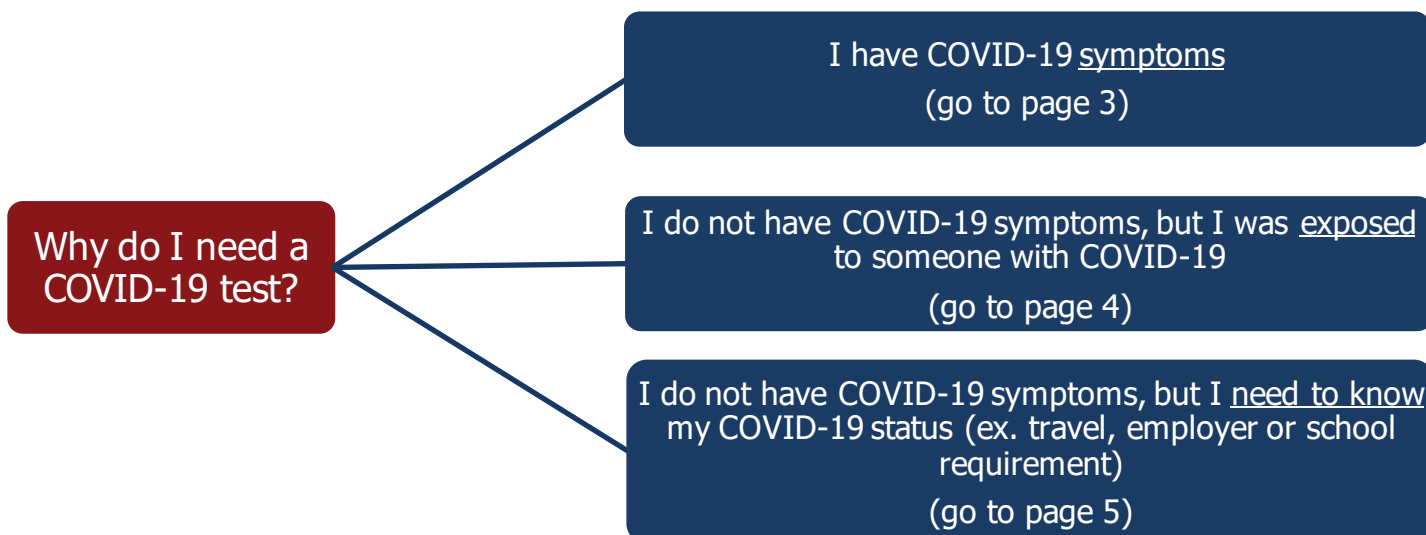

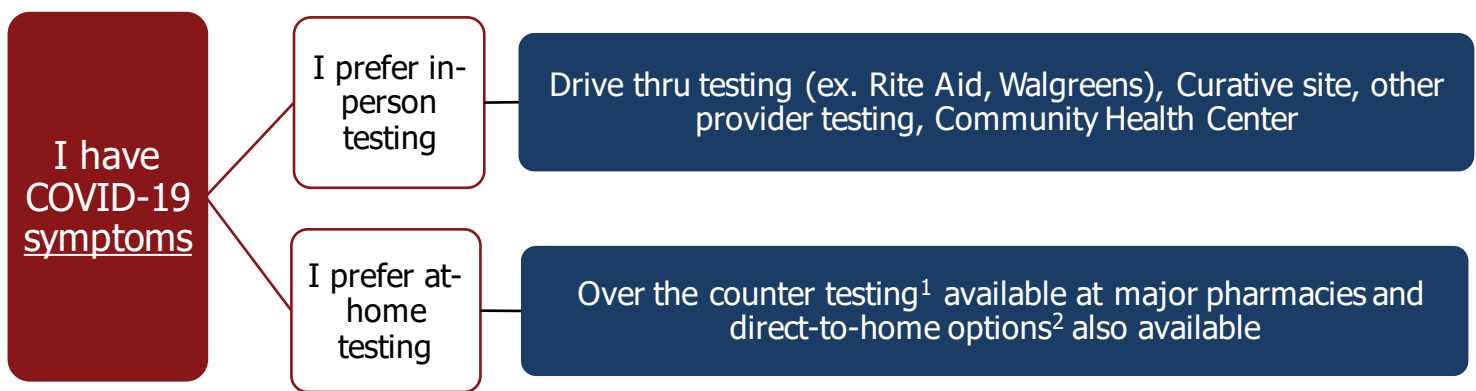

### **Additional Information:**

- You should stay home and isolate if you are symptomatic, except to go get a COVID-19 test
- Lab analyzed tests that are collected at home can take a few days to process. Consider in-person testing if you need results sooner.
- There are potential out of pocket costs with some COVID-19 at-home tests

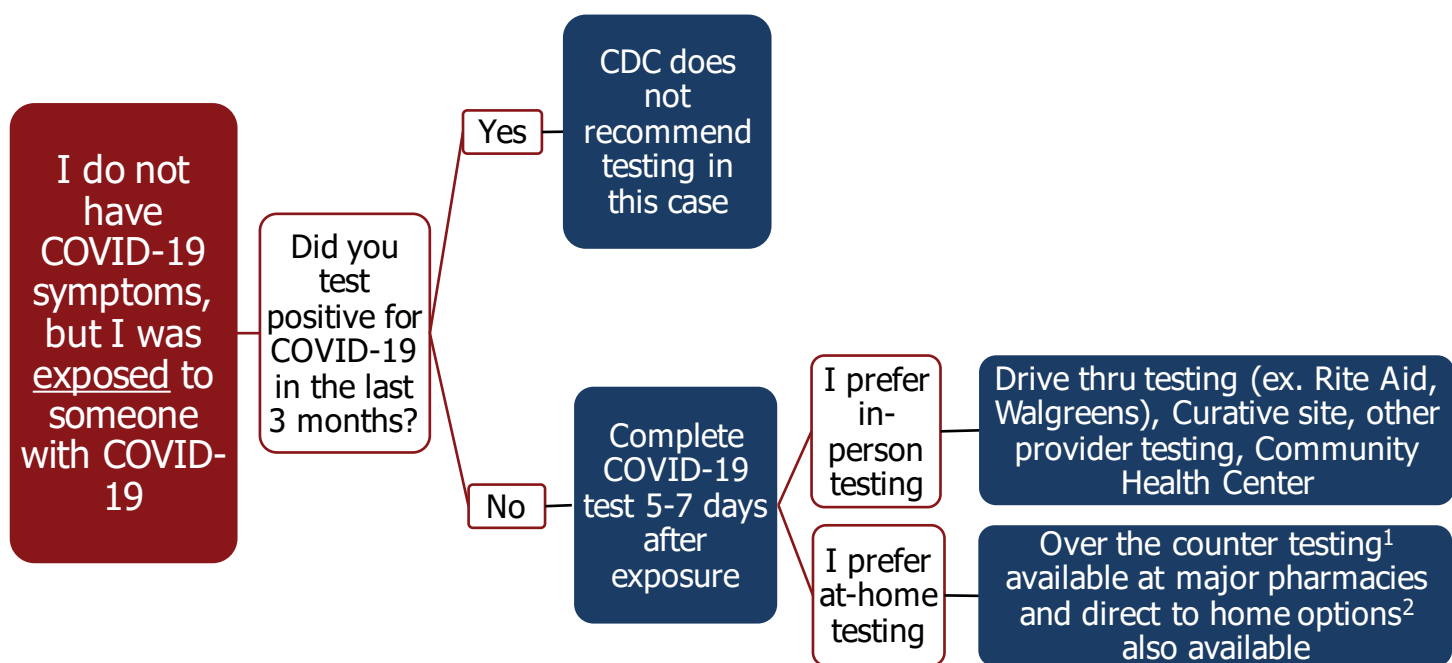

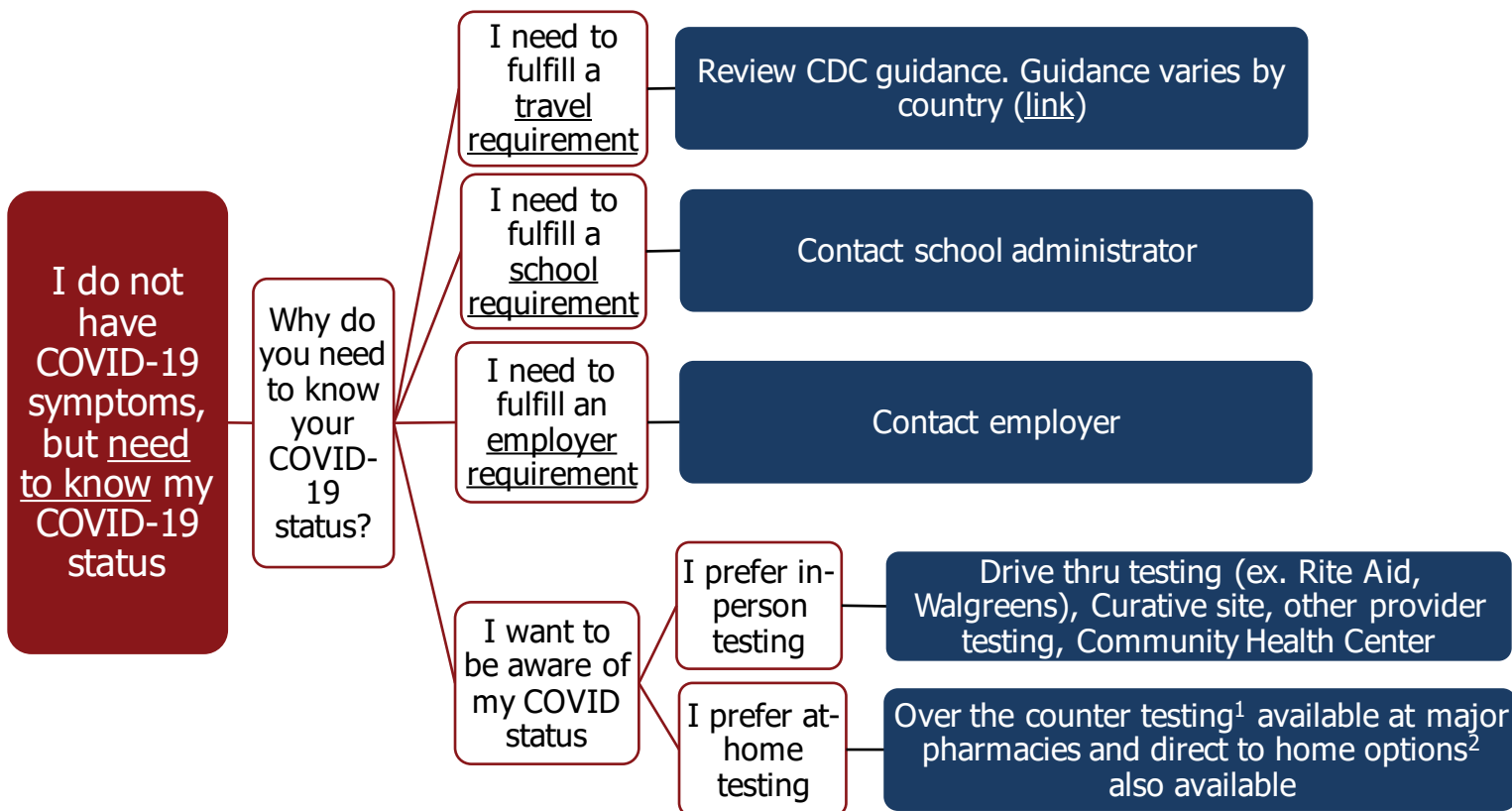

## COVID-19 Tests: Do I Need One and What Kind Do I Need?

### Unless required for work, for school, or for travel, testing is not recommended, if you:

- 1 Are vaccinated and do not have symptoms and have not been exposed to someone with COVID-19; OR
- 2 Recently tested positive and have not completed your 5-day isolation period and 5-day masking period; OR
- 3 Have tested positive with a PCR test within the past 90 days
